



Terms and Conditions

Referral Bonus

- To be eligible to claim under the Referral Bonus Scheme, any Candidates referred to Amicus Recruit must make it known in writing at the point of application, the name of the person who referred them to the Company (eg: application form/email/ referral bonus scheme literature)
- In order for a referral bonus to be paid, the referred Candidate must complete 14 weeks continuous work at a minimum of 30 hours per week. A total of 420 Timesheet hours to be processed via Amicus Recruit for entitlement to Bonus to be approved.
- The scheme can be altered or withdrawn at any time but if a Temporary Worker can achieve a 420 working hours target within 4 weeks of withdrawal, they will be allowed to complete the 4 weeks and receive the original payment. All further payments will be under the New Conditions.
- It is the Temporary Workers' responsibility to track their hours worked/submitted and claim when they have reached the required number.
- Bonus payments will be made on the following basis; 1st Introduction - £200, 2nd Introduction - £350, 3rd Introduction - £450 and all subsequent Introductions to be paid at the value of £550 each.
- If the Referred Candidate's employment with Amicus Recruit prior to the qualifying period for Bonus payout, the Bonus cannot be claimed pro-rate.
- Amicus Recruit's decision on the validity of any claim is final.

1st Introduction £200

2nd Introduction £350

3rd Introduction £450

4th Introduction £550

When Candidates have reached the 4th Introduction, all subsequent Introductions will be paid at £550. In order for the bonus to be paid, the Candidate must complete 14 weeks work @ 30 hours per week minimum. Total hours 420 for Referral Bonus to be paid.
